

- $2. \ When \ unplugged \ from \ the \ outlet, \ the \ power \ line \ shall \ never \ be \ pulled \ and \ dragged.$


You shall grasp the body of AC transformer plug.

Volume


You shall never play music with high volume for a long time. When using earphone, you shall take particular care. Too high volume may do harm to your hearing.

- 3. 3-1 to 3-4 screws M6X60 (4 PCS)

Connection

Audio Input Interface

Before external audio signal is connected to this product, please turn down the volume of tone source at first. Adjust the volume to the satisfactory level after connection.

Connecting wire, which is sold into the open where both ends are standard plugs (for instance : for MP3)

or one end is standard plug while the other end is two needle shaped plug (for instance: for DCD), is used to connect tone source output unit and digital keyboard, and when you switch on power switches of tone source instrument and digital keyboard, you can play music on the tone source instrument of the digital keyboard, or you can also play music while play the musical instrument


USB / MIDI Interfaces

MIDI is initial letters of Musical Instrument Digital Interface in English. MIDI is the standard connecting system of communication between digital keyboard and music instrument with MIDI USB or MIDI interfaces of this digital keyboard can be used to connected with music instrument accompanied with MIDI and computer.

Earphone Output Terminal

This product has one earphone output faucets, and turn down volume of the digital keyboard at first before connecting earphone. Adjust the volume to the satisfactory level after connection

Basic Operation

Piano performance

- 1. Press the power switch, and the power indicator and digital tube.will light up, and then you can enter the playing state.
- 2. Play music on the piano keys.

Volume adjustment

Press the "volume +" or "volume -" button to increase or decrease the volume until it is satisfactory.

Timbre selection

- 1. Press "timbre/rhythm" button, and the indicator light will be on to enter timbre mode.
- 2. Press "select +" or "select -" to select any timbre, and the corresponding timbre number will be displayed digitally.
- 3. When the power switch is turned on, it is preset to the piano tone, with a total of 128 tones.

Rhythm selection

- 1. Press the "Tone/Rhythm" button, the key light goes out and enters the rhythm mode.
- 2. Press "Select+" or "Select-" to select any rhythm, digital display of the corresponding rhythm number.
- 3. Press the "Start/Stop" key to start playing the selected rhythm. Pressing" Insert 1" or "Insert 2" inserts a piece of cross-door music to stop the rhythm play press "Start/Stop".

Speed adjustment

- 1. Press the "Speed" button and press "Select+" or "Select-" to adjust the speed and speed.
- 2. Speed control range (20-280), power-up preset in paragraph 120.

Chord accompaniment

- 1. Select the desired rhythm to play.
- 2. Press and hold the "Tone/Rhythm" and "Function" buttons at the same time to enter the chord state.
- 3. Playing chords can be played differently on the accompaniment keyboard (1-34 keys from left) according to different fingering.
- 4. Press and hold the "Tone/Rhythm" and "Function" buttons again to turn off the chord function.

Shift ingdulation

- 1.Press the "Function" button, digital display "0" into the transfer selection function.
- 2.2. Press "Select +" or "Select-" to select different shift values (-12-12).

Force function

- 1.Press the "function" button, the function light lights up, digital display inverted "F" when entering the force adjustment function.
- 2. Use "Select+" or "Select-" to select force on or force off.

Metronome features

Press the metronome button, the light lights up, the metronome function starts, and then press the key metronome function off.

Built-in Demo Song

- 1. At the same time, press and hold the "Select +" "Select -"Digital display of the current demonstration song number, start playing the demonstration song continuously.
- 2. Entering the demonstration mode can also be "select +" or "select-" to select a

different demonstration song.

3. Press "Select+" and "Select-" again to exit the demonstration mode.

Recording

1. Key disc note recording

Press the "Start/Stop" and "INTRO/End" buttons simultaneously to digitally display "REC" into recording mode, recording 5000 notes.

2. Sounding Press "Insert 1" and "Insert 2" digitally display "'PLY" to play the recorded notes.

SPLIT

- 1. Press the "Function" button, the function light goes on, and the digital display of the first letter "S" enters dual keyboard selection mode.
- 2. Use "Select +" or "Select-" to select both keyboard on or double keyboard off.
- 3. Play notes on the keyboard, at this time playing the keyboard left and right each issued the corresponding sound of the instrument

DUAL

- 1. Press the "Function" button, the function light goes on, and the digital display of the first letter "d" enters dual selection mode.
- 2. Use "Select+" or "Select-" to select a two-tone on or two-tone switch.
- 3. Play notes on the keyboard, at which point playing the keyboard can emit two corresponding resonance tones at the same time.

Accompaniment volume adjustment

- 1. Press the "function" button, the function light lights up, digital display "024" into and put accompaniment volume adjustment mode.
- 2. Use "Select +" or "Select-" to select a different accompaniment volume (0-32).

Storage function

- 1. After setting the various parameters that need to be remembered at present, you can press and hold the "Storage 1" or "Storage 2" button, the corresponding light flashes to indicate that the current setting has been remembered.
- 2. When playing, you need to release the corresponding parameters, just press the corresponding button to release quickly.






Single Finger Chord List

Product Maintenance

Careful and good maintenance and production of this product play a very important role in lengthen service life of the product and decrease fault.

Avoid heating, Damping or direct Sunlight

You shall not have the musical instrument exposed to sunlight in excess, or placed where is near air conditioner or baking hot

you should not use it near TV set or radios

This musical instrument may lead to video or audio disturbance on TV set and

Radio. In that case, you shall move the musical instrument away from TV set or radio

You should not use paint, thinner or similar chemicals to clean

You can clean this product a piece of soft cloth with weak solution and neutral detergent. The piece of cloth shall be dipped and wrung out in the solution until

it is dry approximately.

you should avoid quake and collision

The product shall be handled with care when removing with strict prohibition of strenuous quake and collision in order not to make outer shell or innerelectronic components damaged.

Avoid using where is easy to be affected by abnormal high and low temperatures
