

Its core adopts the top French DREAM sound source, digital sampling, to bring you performance a realistic listening experience.



88 progressive heavy hammer keys, all with heavy hammer keyboard The 88-keys progressive lever hammer keyboard gives you the real feel of playing on a grand piano.



Headphone jack

External headphone jack, in the front of the digital piano function box, enabling you to play without affecting others.



External sound socket, function board at the back of digital piano, can be convenient for external sound, performance and playing.


Special Reminder:

INSTALLATION

Assembly diagram






M4 M5X50 tip tail self-tapping screws, as shown in Figure 1 M6X15 with 4 screws of plastic handle. as shown in Figure 3

Installation steps:

- 1. Fix the left and right supporting plates and the middle fixing plate with 1 PM5x50(4PCS) screws;
- 2. Place the body on the left and right support boards and fix it with screw 3M6x15(4PSC).

Note: The portable model does not include the left and right side panels and the baffle.





Power cable Connection

- Connect the power cord according to the diagram when using.
 one end is inserted into the power socket in the operating board at the bottom
 of the piano, and the other end is inserted into the household power socket.
 (figure 1)
- 2. If you do not use this product for a long time, please unplug the power cord and keep it properly.

Audio input/output jack

1. Audio output socket can be connected to large speakers

CONNECTION JACK

2. The audio input jack can connect the external audio source to the electric piano for playing. (Figure 2 Figure 3)

3 Headphone jack

Connecting headphones will automatically cut off the output from the internal speakers, making it easy to play without disturbing others. (figure 7)


USB transmission interface

The USB transmission interface of the digital piano can be connected to the computer. Through the pre-installed music software on the computer, learning or playing the keyboard to perform, compose, storage and other functions. Edited music and music software built-in accompaniment, can be connected to the digital piano through the software to play, or according to the accompaniment music to play. (figure 4)

5 Extended-tone pedal interface

Insert the end plug of the pedal line into the pedal interface, you can connect the sound effect function of the pedal! (Figure 5) Insert the pedal into the three–step interface according to the 6–hole jack in the figure, and the pedal will have three effects. (soft, sostenuto, sustain)(Figure 6)

1 Power

- 1. Tap the "Power" bottom, the power indicator and LCD screen will light up, you can enter the performance state.
- 2. Play music on the piano keyboard.
- 3. Turn off the power supply when it is not in use.
- The processor chip of this product is complex, similar to the computer system, and sometimes it cannot respond. Please turn off the power switch and then open it to work normally.

2 Tone

- 1. Tap the "Timbre/Rhythm" button and the button indicator will light up to enter the timbre mode. Boot the default tone mode.
- 2. Press the volume knob and adjust the volume knob to select any tone color. The LCD displays the corresponding tone number.
- 3. Find the timbre you need in the timbre list in the Appendix. There are 128 timbres.

Rhythm

- 1. Press the "Timbre/Rhythm" button to turn off the indicator and enter the rhythm mode.
- 2. Press and adjust the volume knob to select any rhythm.
- 3. Press the "Start/Stop" button to play the selected rhythm, and then tap the key to stop playing the rhythm.
- 4. Find the rhythm you need in the appendix rhythm list. There are 100 rhythms.

4 Demo

- 1. Press the first and last keys at the same time to display the number of the current demo song on the LCD and start playing the demo song.
- 2. When entering the demonstration mode, you can also adjust the volume knob to select different demonstration songs. Press the volume knob to enter the volume adjustment mode. The volume can be adjusted (0-64). The default value is 55.
 - 3. Press the first and last white key again to stop playing the demo song.
 - 4. Find the music you need in the appendix song list

Note!

The built-in music library of this product contains 80 songs, which can be used for playing and listening or you can follow the melody on the keyboard with the learning function.

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5 Synchronize/plug in

When you tap the "Synchronize/Insert" button, the corresponding indicator blinks and the synchronization function starts. Press any key to play the rhythm synchronously. Press the "Sync/Insert" button during the rhythm playing which will insert a small drumbeat.

6 Metronome

Tap the "metronome" button, corresponding to the indicator light flash with the beat, display "001", this is the first beat, the second touch display "002", this is the second beat, the third touch display "003", this is the third beat, the fourth touch display" 004", this is the fourth beat, the fifth touch metronome closed.

7 Chord

- 1. Select the rhythm you want to play. For details, refer to the rhythm operation in Point 4.
- 2. Tap the "Chord" button and the corresponding indicator lights up, and the LCD displays that the chord starts to enter the chord state. The use of single multi-finger multiplexing chord mode, where in line with the multi-finger chord playing method, then the piano response to multi-finger chord; Where does not conform to the multi fingered chord playing method, then identifies the response according to the single fingered chord.
- 3. Playing chords can be performed on the accompaniment keyboard (1–34 keys from left) according to different fingerings.
- 4. Press the "Chord" button again to close the chord state.


8 Record/play sound

- 1. Keyboard note recording: Hold down the first white key on the left and touch the "Record/Play" key at the same time to enter the recording mode. Play the keyboard key to enter the note recording, and touch the "Record/Play" again to finish the recording. In keyboard note recording mode, timbre can be changed for recording, and 5000 notes can be recorded.
- 2. Playback Touch "Record/Playback" to play the recorded note.
- 3. Press Reset or power off to clear the recording.

9 Function

- 1. For the first time, enter the shift LCD display "0", use the volume knob to adjust the shift size (-12-12).
- 2. Touch the function button for the second time to enter the speed mode. LCD displays "120" and the volume knob can be used to adjust the speed (20–280).
- 3. Touch the function button for the third time to enter the accompaniment volume mode. On the LCD display, "24" can be used to adjust the accompaniment volume with the volume knob (0–32).
- 4. Touch the function button for the fourth time to enter the equalizer bass mode. LCD display "96" can adjust the bass size with the volume knob (0−127).
- 5. Touch the function button for the fifth time to enter the equalizer treble mode. LCD display "96", use the volume knob to adjust the treble size (0–127).
- 6. Touch the function button for the sixth time to enter the percussion selection mode (61 percussion instruments) and use the volume knob to open or close the percussion function.
- 7. Touch the function button for the seventh time to enter the dual-keyboard selection mode, and use the volume knob to open or close the dual-keyboard function.
- 8. Touch the function button for the eighth time to enter the dual timbre selection mode. Use the volume knob to open or close the dual timbre function.
- Touch the function button for the ninth time to enter the intensity selection mode.
 LCD displays the standard available volume knob to adjust the intensity level (light-standard - heavy-off).
- 10. Touch the function button for the tenth time to enter the reset selection mode. At this time, touch the chord key to restore to the initial state.

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10 Bluetooth mode

Turn on the power to connect bluetooth automatically.

The password for connecting Bluetooth is 8888

- 1. Connect mobile phones, tablets and computers: open Bluetooth devices such as mobile phones and connect to piano-Audioxxxx, complete the connection with the piano.
- Audio Bluetooth introduction: Use the music player APP of mobile phone and other devices to connect to the electronic piano through Bluetooth, you can play music and enjoy songs on the piano
- 3. Introduction of data Bluetooth: Using the music play APP of mobile phone and other devices, , with data bluetooth, you can connect the piano to those apps for learning and practicing purpose.

Note!

After Bluetooth is started, there will be Bluetooth communication and the sound of data scanning chip motherboard, which is a normal phenomenon. Please feel free to use it. After Bluetooth is finished, please turn off Bluetooth in time and disconnect the Bluetooth of mobile phones and other devices.

Piano-audio XXXX: XXXX represents the last 4 bits code for connecting Bluetooth devices such as mobile phones. Because each Bluetooth plate is different, the connection code is different, which is a normal phenomenon. Bluetooth password :8888

Please note that this electronic instrument needs basic maintenance and good care to enhance its service life

Avoid heat, moisture or direct sunlight

Do not overexpose the product to direct sunlight, or place it near air conditioning, or in extremely hot places.

Do not use near TV or radio

This product may cause video or audio interference to TV and radio reception. If this happens, the product should be removed from the TV or radio.

Do not use paint, thinner or similar chemicals for cleaning

Clean the product with a soft cloth moistened with a weak aqueous solution and a neutral detergent. Soak the cloth in the solution and wring until it is nearly dry.

4 Do not shake, avoid collision

The product should be carefully handled when moving, and violent vibration and collision are strictly prohibited to avoid damage to the shell or the internal electronic components.



Note quality is slightly different from note quality under the same timbre	This is a normal phenomenon, due to the different timbre sampling range and produce different sound quality
